



ALLIANCE RIFLE CLUB

Alliance Rifle Club of Alliance, Nebraska was formed May 26, 1949 and has been an active club ever since. From the beginning Alliance Rifle Club has been affiliated with the National Rifle Association.

CLUB RULES

Family Memberships \$60.00 per year
plus must be a current NRA member.
Husband, wife and any children under 18.

Individual Memberships \$60.00 per year
plus must be a current NRA member.

Membership includes a key to the Airport Range, Indoor Range and Fiebig Range.
All Club memberships expire each January.

Membership Rules and Regulations

There are four classes of memberships in Alliance Rifle Club. Any person who has been a member of the Club for more than one year is an ANNUAL MEMBER. He or she may keep the status of Annual Member by paying dues on or before March 15 of each year, by maintaining an active membership in the National Rifle Association and by observing all rules of the Club. Alliance Rifle Club memberships are FAMILY MEMBERSHIPS or Individual Memberships.

Annual Member

An Annual Member is a member in good standing of the National Rifle Association and Alliance Rifle Club. The ANNUAL MEMBER understands that his or her conduct may be subject to review, that appropriate action may be taken to either restrict, probate or terminate his or her membership. These actions, if they should become necessary, will be taken up by the Executive Committee and their vote will govern.

Sponsor

Any ANNUAL MEMBER who is in GOOD STANDING of the National Rifle Association and the Alliance Rifle Club. The SPONSOR will seek out those individuals whom he or she believes will act in a sportsman-like manner and are motivated towards the shooting sport. The SPONSOR is encouraged to educate these people in the Rules and Regulations of the National Rifle Association and Alliance Rifle Club.

Applicant

Any person actively seeking PROBATIONARY MEMBERSHIP in Alliance Rifle Club. This individual is required

to have a SPONSOR and must show proof of membership in the National Rifle Association. An APPLICANT will be required to fill out the appropriate form. It is understood that any attempt to falsify information as is required shall VOID such application. It is agreed and understood that the Board of Directors will have up to 90 days to either ACCEPT or REJECT such application and will so notify the APPLICANT of its decision.

Qualifications for application are: 18 years of age, citizen of U.S., no felony record, and be a current member of the NRA.

Applicants whose membership is approved from January through October will expire the following January. Thereafter, their membership will expire each January.

Applicants whose membership is approved November, and December will have two months added to their first year and expire the following January. Thereafter, their membership will expire each January.

Probationary Member

A Member in good standing of the National Rifle Association and Alliance Rifle Club. He or she is required to have a SPONSOR. At the end of each membership year, all those Probationary Members who have fully complied with all the rules of the Club and have paid all dues automatically become Annual Members. In order to maintain that membership thereafter, they must pay dues and meet the requirements of Annual Members.

It is also understood, that a PROBATIONARY MEMBER may NOT sponsor another member until such a time that he or she is granted ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP. A PROBATIONARY MEMBER shall have full Club rights upon issu-

ance of his or her card, except for the right to VOTE and the right to SERVE as a Club Officer or Director.

Junior Member

ALLIANCE JUNIOR RIFLE CLUB is a division of Alliance Rifle Club. Membership will cost one-half the price of regular membership. JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP will be from September to September of each year. All club rules will be observed by JUNIOR MEMBERS. JUNIOR MEMBERS should be supervised at all times when on the range.

Associate Member

Any member that lives 50 miles or more from Alliance. Application must be made following Club regulations. Cost of ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP will be one-half regular membership and does not include the use of a key to Alliance Rifle Club Ranges. All other requirements are the same as an ANNUAL MEMBER.

Guest

Any person in the ACCOMPANIMENT of either an ANNUAL or a PROBATIONARY MEMBER of Alliance Rifle Club. It is understood that he or she is expected to act in a good sportsman-like manner. It is expected of the ANNUAL and PROBATIONARY MEMBERS to instruct their GUEST in the Rules and Regulations of the Club. A GUEST may not be a terminated member of either the National Rifle Association or Alliance Rifle Club and-or a rejected APPLICANT.

Withdrawn Member

Any person who fails to pay his or her annual dues on or before March 15th of each year will be considered having WITHDRAWN from Alliance Rifle Club. To REINSTATE membership, the WITHDRAWN Member must become a new APPLICANT. It is understood that the annual dues are due in January and that the grace period lasts until March 15.

Honoray Membership

Honorary memberships may be granted by the President or Board of Directors and will be exempt from paying any dues. HONORARY members shall have all the rights and privileges of regular members with the exception of the right to vote, hold office, be a director or have the use of a key to the club ranges.

Terminating Membership

According to Section 8 SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION of the current By-Laws of the Alliance Rifle Club.

CLUB RULES

1. No alcoholic beverages or controlled substances may be used or consumed on the Club premises or any Club ranges before or while shooting.
2. Every member of Alliance Rifle Club must be a member of the National Rifle Association, current and in good standing.
3. No Club building, fixture, equipment, fence, gate lock or other property shall be destroyed or damaged willfully or intentionally.
4. Gate keys shall not be loaned nor shall they be duplicated and-or loaned to non-members.
5. All members must observe the CLUB RANGE RULES.

Failure to obey the rules of the Club may result in disqualification at a match or expulsion from the Club.

Voting Priviliges

Each Family Membership or Individual Membership will have one vote for each vote taken at the annual meeting or special meetings.

FAMILY MEMBERSHIPS : If the husband is unable to attend and vote at the annual meeting or special meeting, his wife may vote for the Family Membership.

Officers, directors and other elected or appointed Club officials shall have one vote for each vote taken at Board of Directors meetings.

Family Memberships: If the wife serves as an officer, director or other elected or appointed Club official, she will have one vote for each vote taken at the annual meeting, special meeting or Board of Directors meeting. And the husband will have one vote for each vote taken at the annual meeting or special meetings.

Hoffland Key

Members wishing a key to use for the Hoffland Range must get approval of the Board and pay a fee of \$10.00. They will be required to put in time and work to help the Club with maintainence and club events.
