

Varmint Rifle Matches

We are hosting Varmint matches on May 23, June 27th & July 31, 2010

I would like to explain the course of fire and rifles used for this match.

Match sight in time is from 8:30 am to 10:00 am. This is the time to get all of your sight settings for the match. Make notes for the match and save yourself problems during the match with adjustments of your scope.

Start match at 10:00am.

The course of fire for this match will be 1 sighting round and 5 scoring rounds for each target. Targets are set at 100 – 150 – 200 – 300 & 400 yards. At each range we will have two targets to choose from. The larger target will have a score value of 1 while the smaller target will have a score value of 2.

Everyone in the groups should assist the shooter by spotting targets, scoring and assisting with mirage and wind changes.

Fee for the match is \$10.00

Rifles used for this match are your basic Varmint calibers. The 223 Remington, 22-250, 220 Swift, 204 Ruger, etc. The targets are mild steel so I would appreciate not shooting big bores like the 25-06 and 260 Remington as they are very hard on the targets.
